

Connected 4 Learning Chromebook Student User Agreement



What is Issued

Each student will be issued a Chromebook, power adapter, and protective case.

Security

The District will take several security steps:

1. Each Chromebook will be identified with asset tags and internal identification to facilitate ongoing tracking of the Chromebook. Tampering with or removal of any identification tags is a violation of the RCISD acceptable use policy.
2. Work with the Royse City High School Resource Officer to alert pawn shops and police department in the surrounding areas to be aware of this District owned equipment.
3. Filter internet usage at home and school. No filter is perfect, parents still need to monitor internet usage at home.
4. If the device is stolen a police report must be accompanied with administrative and parental approval in order for a replacement device to be issued.

Student Guidelines

Chromebook Appearance:

Do not tamper with or remove Chromebook labels. **Do not apply stickers, paint, markers or decorate the Chromebook in any way.** Do not intentionally damage the Chromebook. These are also a violation of the district's acceptable use policy and will result in disciplinary action and possible monetary fees or fines.

Chromebook Sleeves:

Chromebooks should be carried in the sleeve provided or an approved replacement.

Usage:

Chromebooks should be charged and brought to school daily to each class. Failure to bring Chromebooks to class and charged may result in disciplinary action. Chromebooks are monitored and violations of the district's acceptable use policy will result in disciplinary action and possible monetary fees and fines.

Sound:

Sound should be muted at all times unless permission is obtained from the teacher for instructional purposes. Students will provide their own earbuds/headphones if needed.

Fees

Usage Fee:

Each student receiving a district issued Chromebook will pay a usage fee of \$30, to be paid annually. Payment can be made with cash, debit, or credit.

Breakage and Loss:

- If damage should occur to your issued Chromebook, the \$30 fee will be applied to the first authorized repair. Manufacturer defects will not be counted against this fee.
- If there is a second instance of damage the student will be responsible for paying for repair (minimum \$30).
- In the event of a third breakage, the student would lose “take home” privileges and would be provided with a Chromebook for school use only during the day.
- In case of loss/mysterious disappearance (no signs of theft) of Chromebook, the student will be responsible for the complete replacement cost of the Chromebook.
- In the instance of a lost case, the student will be charged a \$30 replacement fee.
- In the instance of a lost/broken charger, the student will need to purchase an **approved** replacement at the current market price. Chargers can be purchased at the campus store.

Buyout Option:

At the end of the school year, all graduating seniors will be given an option to purchase their Chromebook from the district. The usage fee each year buys down the cost of the outright purchase of the Chromebook. The buyout option for the next four years will be as follows:

- Seniors in the '17-'18 school year buyout: \$60
- Juniors in the '17-'18 school year buyout (after senior year): \$30
- Sophomores in the '17-'18 school year buyout (after senior year): \$30
- Freshmen in the '17-'18 school year buyout (after senior year): \$30
